SCHOOL BOARD SEEKS SEARCH FIRM TO HIRE SUPERINTENDENT

NORCO – The Corona-Norco Unified School District School Board votes to seek out search firm to assist with filling the superintendent vacancy.

<u>Superintendent Dr. Michael Lin announced his intent to retire on Tuesday, August 4, 2020</u> after serving the District for a total of 12 years, eight years as superintendent.

"One of the most important functions of a school board member is the hiring of the superintendent. As a board we realize this responsibility rests on us, however, we feel it is important to involve the community in this process which is why we have decided to hire a third-party firm to assist us in finding the right candidate to fill this very important seat," said Mary Helen Ybarra, school board president.

Dr. Lin will continue serving as superintendent until a selection is made to ensure a smooth transition.
